



## Asian-inspired Jacket for Mimosa Jade

*fits a 12 inch Waldorf doll*

### Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn. The model uses Knit Picks Wool of the Andes worsted in Solstice Heather, Ciel, and Conch
- Size 6 (3.5mm) straight needles.
- Size 6 dpn's
- Size E crochet hook.

Gauge: 5 sts = 1 inch

This jacket is worked from the neckline down, seamlessly. Stitches for the sleeves are placed on waste canvas, then worked on dpn's after the jacket body is complete. Stitch markers are used to mark the raglan increases.

The jacket is trimmed in a contrasting yarn in crochet.

Jacket: beginning at the neck edge, CO 32 sts in dark blue.

1: K4, place marker, K8, place marker, K8, place marker, K8, place marker, K4.

2: K32

3: K1, Kinc, Kinc, K1, MM, [K1, Kinc, K4, Kinc, K1, MM] three times, K1, Kinc, K2. 41 sts

4: K3, P35, K3, moving markers as you reach them.

5: K1, Kinc, K2, Kinc, K1, MM, [K1, Kinc, K6, Kinc, K1, MM] three times, K1, Kinc, K3. 50 sts

6: K3, P44, K3 moving markers as you reach them.

7: K1, Kinc, K4, Kinc, K1, MM, [K1, Kinc, K8, Kinc, K1, MM] three times, K1, Kinc, K4. 59 sts

8: K3, P53, K3, moving markers as you reach them.

9: K1, Kinc, K6, Kinc, K1, MM, [K1, Kinc, K10, Kinc, K1, MM] three times, K1, Kinc, K5. 68 sts

10: K3, P62, K3, moving markers as you reach them.

11: K1, Kinc, K8, Kinc, K1, MM, [K1, Kinc, K12, Kinc, K1, MM] three times, K1, Kinc, K6. 77 sts

12: K3, P71, K3, moving markers as you reach them.

13: K1, Kinc, K10, Kinc, K1, MM,, [K1, Kinc, K14, Kinc, K1, MM] three times, K1, Kinc, 7. 86 sts

14: K3, P80, K3

15: K16, place the next 20 sts on a piece of waste yarn, K20, place the next 20 sts on a piece of waste yarn, K10, removing markers as you knit.

16: K3, P40, K3 sts; 46 sts

17: K46

18: K3, P40, K3 sts, 46 sts

The next 16 rows are worked per the chart below. The chart represents 40 sts on the jacket, and does not include the 3 garter stitch sts at the beginning and end of each row. So, after you have worked three garter stitches follow the chart for the next 40 sts, then end the row with three more garter stitches.

19: Change to peach and knit 46

20: K3, P40, K3 in peach; change to main color at the end of row 20

21: K46 in main color

22: K3, P40, K3 in main color

23: K3 in main color, knit the chart for 40 sts, K3 in main color.

24: K3 in main color, purl the chart for 40 sts, K3 in main color.

25-29: Proceed to follow the chart, remembering to work three garter stitches at the beginning and end of each row.


30: K3, P40, K3 in main color

31: K46 in main color

32: K3, P40, K3 in main color. Change to peach at the end of row 32

33: K46 in peach

- 34: K3, P40, K3 in peach. Change to main color at the end of row 34
- 35: K46 in main color.
- 36: K3, P40, K3 in main color
- 37: K46 in main color
- 38: K46 in main color, bind off knitwise at the end of row 38.



For each sleeve, place the stitches on three dpns, seven stitches on needle 1 and needle 2 and six stitches on needle 3. Pick up one stitch under the arm and put it on needle 3. 21 sts, seven sts per needle.


1: K21 around.

2: On each needle, K3, Kinc, K3. 24 sts total. At the end of row 2, change to peach yarn

3-13: Knit the chart below for each sleeve, starting with peach yarn

14: K24 sts in main color

15: P24 sts in main color, bind off knitwise



Trim: with peach yarn and size E crochet hook, work (slip stitch, ch1) trim all around the edge of the jacket, starting at the center back bottom edge. Make three buttonhole loops at the neckline, and at both peach stripes by making a (slip stitch, ch5, slip stitch) in the same stitch.

## Fur Trimmed Boots

## Materials:

- Worsted yarn in dark brown. Model uses Berrocco Vintage in dark brown
- Eyelash yarn for fur trim. Model uses Yarn Bee Elvish in mocha
- Size 4 (3.5mm) dpn's

Gauge: 5.5 sts = 1 inch

Boots: Cast on 6 sts with brown and divide evenly over three size 4 dpns; two sts per needle.

1: K6

2: Kinc in each st around, 12 sts

3: K12

4: K1, Kinc, Kinc, K1 on each needle. 18 sts, 6 sts per needle

5: K18

6: K2, Kinc, K3 on each needle. 21 sts, 7 sts per needle

7-10: K21

11: Working on needle 1 only, K7. Leave the other two needles to dangle

12: on needle 1, P7

13: on needle 1, K7

14: on needle 1, P7

15: On needle 1, K7, pick up three sts along the heel side and place on needle 1

On needle 2, K7

On needle 3, K7, pick up three sts along the heel side and place on needle 3.

16: K8, K2tog on needle 1

K7 on needle 2

K8, K2tog on needle 3

17: K7, K2tog on needle 1

K7 on needle 2

K7, K2tog on needle 3

18: K6, K2tog on needle 1

K7 on needle 2

K6, K2tog on needle 3

19-23: K21 around. At the end of round 23, change to eyelash yarn for fur trim on the boots.

24-26: K21 around in eyelash yarn. Bind off knitwise at the end of round 26. Weave in the ends and you are done!
