



Simple knit sweater for Bleuette

baw 9/11/2012

Materials:

- Worsted yarn, I used Soy Wool Stripes by Patons
- Size 4 (3.5mm) single pointed knitting needles
- Size D crochet hook for picking up sleeve stitches.

Gauge: 5sts = 1 inch

Back. Cast on 18 sts

1-4: K18

5: P18

6: K18

7-20: Repeat rows 5 and 6

21: K18, bind off knitwise.

Front. Cast on 18 sts

1-4: K18

5: P18

6: K18

7-13: Repeat rows 5 and 6.

Left front:

14: K9, turn. Leave remaining sts unworked on your needle

15: K3, P6.

16: K9

17-20: Repeat rows 15 and 16

21: K9, bind off knitwise.

Right Front:

14: Attach yarn, K9.

15: P6, K3

16: K9

17-20: Repeat rows 15 and 16

21: K9, bind off knitwise.

With the wrong sides together, sew the front to the back at the shoulder with four overcast stitches.

Sleeve: measure up 1 1/4 inches from the bottom edge of the front and the back and mark with two pins.

With the right side facing, pick up 18 stitches between the pins with the crochet hook, and place them on your needle.

1: K18

2: K 18

3: P 18

4: K 18

5-18: Repeat rows 3 and 4.

19: K18

20: K18

21: K 18. Bind off knitwise leaving a long tail to sew up the side and arm seam.

Repeat for the opposite sleeve. Sew up the arm and side seam and your done!
