



Crochet Hitty crochet Quaker style dress

Materials

- Size 10 crochet cotton (I used Curio in bluebell)
- Size 7 steel crochet hook
- Four ¼ inch black buttons

Gauge: 9sc = 1 inch

Link Stitch = (Ch3, dc in the third ch from the hook), one link made. Continue with (ch3, dc in the

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third ch from the hook) for as many links as called for in the pattern. Each link has a dc side and a ch3 side. When asked to work in the link, work over one side, the side closest to your hook.

FLO = front loop only

Picot = ch2, sl st in the top of the last stitch made. Or, ch3, single crochet in the top of the last stitch made.

Bodice:

1: Make seven links, ch2, turn.

2: Work 5dc in each link across, ch1, turn. 35dc

3: (Sc in the first four dc, two sc in the next dc) across, ch2, turn. 42 sc

4-5: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 42 sc

6: Sc in the first five sc, ch4, skip next 11 sc, sc in the next 10sc, ch4, skip next 11sc, sc in the last five sc, ch1, turn. 20 sc, 8 ch, armholes made

7: Sc in each sc and ch across, ch1, turn. 28 sc

8-11: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 28 sc

Skirt:

12: FLO, (sc in the first sc, 5dc in the next sc) across. Join to the beginning sc, ch2 (does NOT count as first dc) turn. 84Sts

13: (5dc in the sc, skip next two dc, sc in the next dc, skip next two dc) across. The round will end with a sc. Join to the beginning dc, ch2, turn.

14-30: Repeat round 13 for the desired length of the skirt.

31: [(Dc, picot) five times in the next sc, skip the next two dc, sc in the next dc, skip the next two dc] around. Finish off.

Sleeves:

1: Join thread with a sc in the first sc under the armhole opening; sc in the next three sc, dc in the side of the next stitch, dc in the next 11 sts, dc in the side of the next st, join to the beginning sc, ch1, do not turn. 17 sts

2: Sc in the first st, sc next two sts tog, sc in the next st, dc in the next 13 sts, join to the beginning sc, ch2, do not turn.

3-5: Dc in each st around, join, ch2, do not turn. At the end of round 5, ch1.

6-7: Sc in each st around, join, ch1, do not turn.

8: Sl st a bit loosely in the back loop of each st around. Finish off. Repeat for second sleeve.

Buttonhole loops and neckline trim.

Join thread at the bottom back of the bodice with a sl st, ch4, skip next two rows, sl st in the next three rows, ch4, skip next two rows, sl st in the next three rows, ch4, sl st into the first link at the neckline, ch1.

For neckline trim work (3sc, picot) in each link across. End with 3 sc in the last link and finish off.

Weave in the loose ends and sew three small button opposite the buttonhole loops and you're done!

The bonnet pattern is from the Hitty's Knittys Yahoo group, and the garter stitch shawl is from a human size pattern on the Lionbrand site, worked on size 0 needles and using size 10 crochet cotton.
