



Tiny Superhero Cape

For Feel Better Friends and other 12 inch dolls

Materials

- Dk or sportweight yarn
- Size D crochet hook
- 3/8 to 1/2 inch button

Gauge: not really important, just make sure the neckline fits comfortably around the dolls neck and that the cap is the length you want.

Starting at the neckline, leave a long tail to make a buttonhole loop

1: Ch26, sc in the second ch from the hook and each ch across, ch1, turn. 25Sc

2: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 25Sc

3: Sl st in the first five sts, 2sc in the next 15sts,leave the last five sts unworked, ch1, turn. 10 sl sts, 30 sc

4: (Sc in the first two sc, two sc in the next sc)10 times, ch1, turn. 40 sc

5-24: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 40Sc

25-28: Skip the first sc, sc across to the last two sc, skip the next sc, sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. Finish off at the end of row 28.

With white yarn, embroider TINY SUPERHERO in straight stitches on the back of the cape. Add some yellow starbursts around the words. Make a ch5 buttonhole loop with the long tail at the neck and sew a button on the opposite side of the neckband. I suggest dampening the cape and laying it flat to get the 'curl' out of the corners. And you're done!
