



## Simple Knit Sundress for Forget-Me-Knot kids

### Materials:

- DK weight (light sportweight) yarn
- Size 1 single point knitting needles
- Size 2 crochet hook
- Two 1/4 inch buttons
- DK weight yarn to optionally embroider the hem of the dress

Gauge: seven sts = 1 inch

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Front: cast on 12 sts

1-2: K12

3: P12

4-9: repeat rows 2 and 3

10: K12

11: K12, bind off knitwise leaving a long tail to sew the shoulder seam.

First back: cast on 7 sts

1-2: K7

3: P5, K2

4: K7

5-10: Repeat rows 3 and 4

11: K7, Bind off knitwise leaving a long tail to sew shoulder seams

Second back: cast on 7 sts

1-2: K7

3: K2, P5

4: K7

5-10: Repeat rows 3 and 4

11: K7, Bind off knitwise leaving a long tail to sew shoulder seams

With the right sides together, stitch the front to the backs beginning at the waist edge and backstitching for three stitches. Leave the remaining edge unstitched for the arm holes.

Skirt: with the right side facing you, use the crochet hook to pick up stitches at the waist edge for the skirt.

1: P across.

2: K1 in the first st, K2 in each st across to the last st, K1 in the last st.

3: P across

4: K across

5-10: Repeat rows 3 and 4

11: K across

12: K across

13-18: Repeat rows 3 and 4

19: K across. Bind off knitwise and leave a long tail to sew up the center back seam.

Sew two stitches at each shoulder for the shoulder seams. With the crochet hook work two buttonhole loops on one back of the dress.

If you want to embroider the hem of the dress, do this before sewing up the center back seam. French knots for flowers, single lazy daisies for leaves, or a featherstitch are a nice embroidered touch.

Stitch up the center back seam and sew two buttons opposite the button hole loops.

## Easy easy knit undies:

Cast on 22 sts

1-2: K22

3: P22

4-8: Repeat rows 2 and 3

9: K22, bind off knitwise leaving a tail to sew up the center back seam and make the crotch.

Right sides together, sew the center back seam from the waist to the leg edge. Center the center back seam with the center front of the undies and take two to three stitches to create the crotch and the leg openings. Turn the the right side and you're done!
