



## Grace Notes Nightgown

### Materials:

- DK/Sportweight yarn. Model made with Loops & Threads Snuggly Wuggly
- Size 3 straight and double point needles

**Gauge:** 6 sts = 1 inch in stockinette

**Terms:** yfd = yarn forward then knit the next st taking the yarn across the needle and thus increasing by one stitch. This is a lace stitch that intentionally creates a hole in the fabric.

PM = place marker. To denote the true end of the rows once the armholes are added.

MM = Move marker.

**Note:** The lace edging of the nightgown is worked on straight needles for 16 rows, then the nightgown is worked onto four double point needles. The nightgown is completed in the round.

**Nightgown:** begins at the bottom edge, CO 61 sts on single point needles

1: K61

2: P61

3: \*K1, (K2tog) twice, (yfd, K1) 3 times, yfd, (K2tog) twice, repeat from \* to the last st, K1

4: K 61

5: K61

6: P61

7: \*K1, (K2tog) twice, (yfd, K1) 3 times, yfd, (K2tog) twice, repeat from \* to the last st, K1

8: K61

9: K61

10: P61

11: \*K1, (K2tog) twice, (yfd, K1) 3 times, yfd, (K2tog) twice, repeat from \* to the last st, K1

12: K61

13: K61

14: P61

15: \*K1, (K2tog) twice, (yfd, K1) 3 times, yfd, (K2tog) twice, repeat from \* to the last st, K1

16: K59, K2tog. 60 sts

17: Knit 60 sts onto four dpns with 15 sts per needle. From this point on you will work in rounds on the dpns.

18: K15 on each needle

19: K1, K2tog, K9, K2tog, K1 on each needle. 52 sts

20-22: K13 on each needle

23: K1, K2tog, K7, K2tog, K1 on each needle. 44 sts

24-26: K11 on each needle

27: K1, K2tog, K5, K2tog, K1 on each needle. 36 sts

28-30: K9 on each needle.

31: K3, K2tog, K4 on each needle. 32 sts

32: Bind off four sts, K12; bind off four sts, K12. PM after last st to mark the true end of the row. CO eight sts on the fourth needle.

33: Needle 1: K4

Needle 2: K8, CO eight sts.

Needle 3: K4

Needle 4: K8, MM, K8 across the cast on stitches.

34: Needle 1: K4

Needle 2: K8, K8 across the cast on stitches.

Needle 3: K4

Needle 4: K6, Kdec, MM, (K2, Kdec) twice.

35: Needle 1: K4

Needle 2: K6, Kdec, (K2, Kdec) twice.

Needle 3: K4

Needle 4: K7, MM, (K1, Kdec, Kdec, K1).

36: Needle 1: K4

Needle 2: K7, (K1, Kdec, Kdec, K1)

Needle 3: K4

Needle 4: K7. Bind off all sts knitwise.

Sew the edges of the lace hem together with a mattress stitch. Done!
