



Grace Notes raglan sleeve cardigan sweater

Designed for the nine inch knit Grace Notes doll

Materials:

- Light worsted yarn. I used SWTC Kara (50gms/100meters) Berroco Vintage or Patons Classic Wool would also work (they are 100gms/200meters per skein)
- Dpn's in size 3. Five each
- Single point needles in size 3

Gauge: 11 sts = 2 inches in stockinette stitch

Designed by Beth Webber. Please do not copy or sell this free pattern.

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Sleeves: CO 20 sts and distribute evenly over four size 3 dpns: 5 sts per needle

1-4: Work K2, P2 ribbing for four rounds.

5-12: K20

13 : BO 4 sts, knit 16 (including the last st from bind off). Cut the yarn leaving a long tail and place sts on spare dpn, and repeat for other sleeve.

Body: CO 40sts on size 3 single point needles.

1-4: Work K2, P2 ribbing for four rows.

5-12: Work the first three and last three stitches of each row in garter stitch (knit each row), and the remaining stitches in stockinette stitch, beginning with knit row.

13: Shape armhole: Knit 8, bind off 4, Knit 16 (including the last stitch from bind off), bind off 4, Knit 8 (including the last stitch from bind off).

Add the sleeves and work next wrong side row on single point needles; a total of 64 sts; remember to work garter stitch in the first three and last three stitches of the sweater. Place a stitch marker at each intersection between the body and the sleeve (four markers total).

Continue working in stockinette (K one row, P one row). Shape the raglan seams on the right side rows as follows: before and after each stitch marker work K2tog, K1, slip marker, K1, K2tog. Decrease on the right side (knit) rows until there are 32 sts left; remembering to work garter stitches in the first three and last three stitches of the sweater. Work one more Purl row. Work three rows of K2, P2 ribbing. Bind off knitwise.

Seam the underarms, weave in the ends, and your sweater is finished!
