



Knit Bedjacket for 8-10 inch Waldorf Doll

baw 12-16-2011

Materials:

- Sportweight yarn (size 3)
- Size 4 knitting needles (3.5mm)

Gauge: gauge is not really important for this garment

The pattern stitch for this garment is from the book "Teach Yourself Visually: Knitting"

This is the simplest of designs. You knit a rectangle, fold it lengthwise and sew the two short ends from the edge to within 1 1/2 inches of the fold. The openings are where the arms go through, and the jacket fits like a shrug. Once the garment is on the doll, roll the front edges back to form a shawl collar. Cute, simple, easy!

Cast on 34 sts (or a multiple of four stitches plus two...eg: 6, 10, 14, 18)

1: K34

2: K34

3: K2, *P2, K2; repeat from * across

Repeat row three until the piece measures five inches long. For the last two rows, K34 for each row.

Bind off.

Fold the piece so you have a rectangle that is six or so inches long and 2 1/2 inches wide. Sew each short end up from the edge to within 1 1/2 inches from the fold. The arms go through these openings, and you are finished!
