



Little Sister Pants

Pull on pants for Fiona McDonald's Babe's Little Sister doll.

Materials:

- Worsted yarn. I used Berroco Vintage worsted
- Size 6 knitting needles plus spare double point needle
- Size 4 knitting needles
- Size D crochet hook

Gauge: 4.5 sts = 1 inch

Pants: start with the leg, CO 30; leave a very long tail (at least three feet) to crochet up the leg inseam.
1-3: K30
4: P30
5: K30
6-40 : Repeat rows 4 and 5. At the end of row 40 break off yarn leaving a long tail and place stitches on a spare double point needle.

Work the second leg the same as the first, but do not break yarn.

41: K30 across the stitches on the needle, then knit 30 across the stitches held on the double points.
42: P60
43: K60
44-48 : Repeat rows 42 and 43.
49: (K next four, K2tog) across. 50 sts
50: P50
51: K50
52-54: Repeat rows 50 and 51
55: (K next three, K2tog) across. 40 sts
56: P40
57: K40
58-60: Repeat rows 56 and 57
61: Change to size 4 needles and work (K2, P2) ribbing across.
62-64: Repeat row 61, bind off in pattern, do not cut yarn.

With size D crochet hook and the right sides together, slip stitch the leg inseams up to the crotch. With right side together, slip stitch the center back seam from the waist to the crotch. Weave in the ends and you're done. These pants slip on and fit nicely over the bikini panties. Make shorts or capri's by varying the length.
