



Little Sister Raglan Sweater; adapted from Arne&Carlos design

Materials:

- Copy of Arne&Carlos Knit Dolls book
- Worsted weight yarn. I used Patons Classic Wool
- Size 6 double point needles
- Size 4 double point needles.

Gauge: 9 sts = 2 inches

Work Basic Pattern 3: Thin Sweater from Arne&Carlos Knitted dolls, with the following exceptions:

1. Use worsted weight yarn, and size 4 needles for the small and size 6 needles for the large.
2. Work five rounds of ribbing, then 25 more rounds for the body, for a total of 31 rounds.
3. Work the sleeves to the pattern.
4. Once the sleeves are joined, work the decreases down to 32 stitches.
5. Work the turtleneck with the larger needles for 20 rounds. I suggest binding off the neck edge with size 8 needles...my neck edge was a bit tight, but my knit Little Sister could still get into it, with a little squeezing.
