



## Little Sister Sweater

*Sweater for Fiona McDonald's Babe's Little Sister doll*

### Materials:

- Sportweight/DK weight yarn. I used Universal Bella DK
- Size 4 knitting needles
- Size C crochet hook

Gauge: 5 sts = 1 inch

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A very simple cardigan sweater made from squares. One square for back, two for front, and two knitted into the side seams for sleeves.

**Back:** CO 28

1-4: K2, P2 ribbing across

5: K28

6: P28

7-28: Repeat rows 5 and 6

29-32: K2, P2 ribbing across. Bind off in pattern, leaving a long tail.

**Right Front:** CO16

1-4: K2, P2 ribbing across

5: K16

6: P13, K3

7-28: Repeat rows 5 and 6

29-32: K2, P2, ribbing across. Bind off in pattern, leaving a long tail

**Left front:** CO16

1-4: K2, P2 ribbing across

5: K16

6: K3, P13

7-28: Repeat rows 5 and 6

29-32: K2, P2, ribbing across. Bind off in pattern, leaving a long tail

Sew fronts to back at shoulder seams for six stitches.

**Sleeves:** Measure two inches down from the shoulder seam on both the front and back. With the right side facing you, pick up 28 sts evenly between these points. I find this is easiest done with a crochet hook to pick up the stitches.

1: P28

2: K28

3- 30 : repeat rows 1 and 2

31-34: K2, P2 ribbing across. Bind off in pattern but do not cut yarn. With right sides together, slip stitch the arm and side seam together. Finish off and weave in the ends. Repeat for the other sleeve.
