



Mini Hitty Bloomers, Panties, Camisoles, and Chapeau's

fits crochet Mini Hitty, about 4 ½ inches tall.

Materials:

- Size 10 crochet cotton. Knit Picks Curio and DMC Cebelia were used for the models.
- Size 7 steel crochet hook
- 1/4 inch buttons

Gauge: 10sc = 1 inch

Bloomers: Ch80 tightly, fasten off. Fold the chain in half and work around the chain for the waistband, NOT in the chains.

1: Beginning ½ inch from the midpoint of the ch80, 32 sc around the chain length, ch1, turn.

2: Sc in each sc across, ch2, turn. (Ch2 does NOT count as the first dc, ever)

3: Dc in each sc across, join, ch2, do not turn. 32Dc

4-5: Dc in each dc across, join, ch2, do not turn. 32dc.

First leg:

6: Skip first 16 dc, sl st in the next dc, ch2, dc in the same st as ch2 and in each dc and ch around, join, ch1, do not turn.

7: Sc in each dc around, join, finish off or work (sl st, ch1) in the same color or in a contrasting color.

Second leg:

6: Join in the first unused dc on round6 and work as per the first leg.

Panties:

1: Ch13, sc in the second ch from the hook and each ch across, ch1,turn. 12sc.

2: Sc first two sc tog, sc in the next eight sc, sc the last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 10 sc.

3: Sc first two sc tog, sc in the next six sc, sc the last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 8sc.

4: Sc first two sc tog, sc in the next four sc, sc the last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 6sc.

5: Sc first two sc tog, sc in the next two sc, sc the last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 4sc.

6: Sc first two sc tog, sc the last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 2sc.

7-11: Sc in the next two sc, ch1, turn. 2sc.

12: Two sc in the first sc, two sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. 4sc.

13: Two sc in the first sc, sc in the next two sc, two sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. 6sc.

14: Two sc in the first sc, sc in the next four sc, two sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. 8sc.

15: Two sc in the first sc, sc in the next six sc, two sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. 10sc.

16: Two sc in the first sc, sc in the next eight sc, two sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. 12sc. Join with a sl st to the first sc of the opposite side of the panties, ch1.

17: Sc in each sc around the entire waistline of the panties, join to the first sc, ch1, turn. 24 sc.

18: (Sc in the next four sc, sc next two sc tog) around, join, finish off. 20 sc.

For each leg opening, join thread at the top of the hip and work (sl st, ch2) in the side of each row all around the leg opening. Finish off and weave in all the ends.

Cloche with flower

1. With blue, Ch3, 12 dc in the the third ch from the hook. Join to the first dc. 12 dc
- 2: 2dc in each dc around. Join, ch2 24 dc
- 3: (Dc in the first st, 2dc in the next) around. Join, ch2. 36 dc
- 4: (Dc in the first eight sts, 2dc in the next st) around. Join, ch2. 40 dc
- 5: Sc in each st around, join, ch2. 40 sc
- 6: (Dc in the first st, ch1, skip the next st) around, join, ch1
- 7: Sl st into the first ch1 space. In each ch1 space work (sc, 2dc) around. Finish off.

Flower, with yellow thread:

- 1: ch2, 10sc in the second ch from the hook, join. Ch1.
- 2: (Sc, ch3, skip the next st) around. Join, fasten off. 5 ch3 loops.
- 3: With pink thread, sl st into the first ch3 loop. In each ch3 loop work (sc, 3dc,sc) around. Join. Five small petals made
- 4: Sl st around the base of the first sc on round 2 (you will be working behind the first row of petals), (ch4, sl st around the base of the next sc in round 2) all around. Join to the first sl st. Five ch4 loops
- 5: Sl st into the first ch4 loop. In each ch4 loop work (sc, dc, 3trc, dc, sc) around. Five larger petals made. Finish off and sew to the cloche.

Sunhat

1. With yellow, Ch3, 12 dc in the the third ch from the hook. Join to the first dc. 12 dc
- 2: 2dc in each dc around. Join, ch2 24 dc
- 3: (Dc in the first st, 2dc in the next) around. Join, ch2. 36 dc
- 4: (Dc in the first eight sts, 2dc in the next st) around. Change to white, join, ch1. 40 dc
- 5: FLO, Sc in each st around, change to green, join, ch2. 40 sc
- 6: FLO, (skip the first st, dc in the next dc, then dc in the skipped st behind the first dc...dc-cross-stitch made), repeat around. Change to white at the end of the round, join, ch1, do not turn
- 7: FLO, (Sc in the first st, 2sc in the next st) around, change to yellow, ch1, do not turn. 60 sc
- 8-9: Sc in each st around, join, ch1, do not turn.
- 10: (Sc in the next two sc, two sc in the next sc) around, join, ch1, do not turn. 80Sc
- 11: Sc in each sc around
- 12: (Sc in the first sc, dc in the next sc) around, join, finish off

Rib = two sc rows on the camisole.

FLO = Front Loop Only

BLO = Back Loop Only

Link = (ch3, dc in the third ch from the hook). One link made; work as many links as called for in the pattern. The link has a ch3 side and a dc side. When asked to 'work in the link' you will work around one side of the link.

Camisole top: begin with light green

- 1: Ch4, sc in the second ch from the hook and the next two ch, ch1, turn. 3Sc
- 2-8: Sc in each sc, ch1, turn. 3Sc
- 9: Two sc in the first st, sc in the next st, two sc in the last st, ch1, turn. 5sc.
- 10: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 5Sc
- 11: Two sc in the first sc, sc in the next three sc, two sc in the last sc, ch1, turn. 7sc.
- 12-15: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 7Sc
- 16: Sc first two sc tog, sc in the next three, sc last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 5Sc
- 17: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 5sc.
- 18: Sc the first two sc tog, sc in the next sc, sc last two sc tog, ch1, turn. 3sc.
- 19-26: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. At the end of row 26, turn the work so you are working across the bottom of the camisole.

Across the bottom of the camisole work (three sc in the first rib, two sc in the next rib) across. 33 sc, ch1, turn the work so you are working along one side of the camisole, sl st in each st, ch1.

Turn the work so you are working across the top of the camisole. Work two sc in each rib across. 26sc. Ch1, turn the work so you are working back across the top of the camisole.

Armhole and neckline:

- 1: In FLO, sc in the first five sc, work three links, skips three sc, sc in the next 10 sc, work three links, skip three sc, sc in the last five sc, ch1, turn.
- 2: Sc in the first three sc, sc next two sc tog. Work 2sc in each link across the top of the first armhole

opening (six sc total), sc next two sc tog, sc in the next six sc, sc next two sc tog. Work 2sc in each link across the top of the second armhole opening, sc next two sc tog, sc in the last three sc. Ch4, turn. Make two ch4 buttonhole loops evenly spaced down the side of the camisole.

You can use this as a top with pants, or attach a skirt or bloomers to the bottom. I am going to crochet a skirt to the bottom of the cami top, the same color as the top, so I will not fasten off the thread but continue working:

Skirt:

1: Sl st into the first sc along the bottom edge of the camisole, ch2 (does NOT count as the first dc).

Two dc in the back loop of each sc across. Join to the first dc, ch2, do NOT turn. 66dc

2-3: Dc in each dc across, ch2, do not turn. At the end of round 3, change to white, join, ch1, do not turn.

4: FLO, sc in each dc across. At the end of round four, change to yellow (do not cut the white thread), join, ch2, do not turn.

5: FLO, (skip the first st, dc in the next dc, then dc in the skipped st behind the first dc...dc-cross-stitch made), repeat around. Change to white at the end of the round, join, ch1, do not turn.

6: FLO, sc in each st around, change to green, join, ch1, do not turn.

7: FLO, (sc, 2dc in the first st, skip the next st) around. Finish off and weave in the loose ends.

Neckline and waistline trim: with white.

In BLO, (sl st, ch1) in each st around the neckline. For the waistline trim, work in the free loops and (sl st, ch1) in each stitch.

Sew buttons opposite the buttonhole loops and you're done!
