



## **Mini Hitty Crochet Top and Capri's**

*designed to fit crochet mini Hitty and other 4 ½ inch dolls, like Mattel's Kelly*

### **Materials:**

- Size 10 crochet cotton. Model uses Aunt Lydia's Crochet Cotton 10 in four colors.
- Size 6 steel crochet hook
- Three ¼ inch buttons

Gauge: 8sc = 1 inch

Ch1 does NOT count as the first sc

**Top:** begin at the neckline

1: Ch29, sc in the second ch from the hook and each ch across, ch1, turn. 28 sc

2: Sc in the first four sc, ch4, skip 6 sc, sc in the next eight sc, ch4, skip 6 sc, sc in the final four sc, ch1, turn. 16sc, 8ch ; armhole openings made.

3: Sc in each sc and ch across, ch1, turn. 24 sc.

4: (Sc in the first five sc, two sc in the next) across, ch1, turn. 28 sc

5: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 28 sc

6: (2sc in the first sc, sc in the next six sc) across, ch1, turn. 32 sc

7: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 32Sc

8: (Sc in the first seven sc, two sc in the next sc) across, ch1, turn. 36 sc

9-10: Sc in each sc across, ch1, turn the work so you are working up one side of the top.

Make three buttonhole loops evenly spaced, each one of four chains, with sl sts between the loops.

Join contrasting color at the bottom edge of the top and work (sc, ch1) in each st across. Fasten off.

Join contrasting color at the neck edge of the top and work (sl st, ch1) in each st across. Fasten off.

Weave in the ends, and sew the buttons opposite the buttonhole loops.

### **Flower applique:**

With contrasting flower color, ch2, six single crochet in the second ch from the hook. Join to the first sc with sl st and fasten off.

With main flower color, join with a sl st in the back loop of any sc and work (ch1, 2dc, ch1, sl st) in the back loop of each sc around. Fasten off. Six petals made.

### **Leaf applique:**

With leaf color, ch six, sl st in the second ch from the hook, sc in the next ch, hdc in the next ch, 2hdc in the next ch, 3hdc in the last ch. Working on the opposite side, 2hdc in the next ch, hdc in the next ch, sc in the next ch, sl st and finish off in the last ch.

Make a stem for the flower on the top with embroidered chain or straight stitches, then apply the leaf to the top, and the flower over the bottom edge of the leaf.

**Capri's:** Ch90 tightly, fasten off. Fold the chain in half and work around the chain for the waistband, NOT in the chains.

1: Beginning ½ inch from the midpoint of the ch90, 32 sc around the chain length, ch1, turn.

2: Sc in each sc across, ch2, turn. (Ch2 does NOT count as the first dc, ever)

3: Dc in each sc across, join, ch2, do not turn. 32Dc

4-5: Dc in each dc across, join, ch2, do not turn. 32dc.

First leg:

6: Skip first 16 dc, sl st in the next dc, ch2, dc in the same st as ch2 and in each dc and ch around, join, ch1, do not turn. 18 dc

7: Dc in the first 16dc, dc next two dc tog, join, ch2. 17Dc

8: Dc in the first 15dc, dc next two dc tog, join, finish off.

9: Join contrasting color to the first dc and work (sl st, ch1) in each st around. Join and fasten off.

**Second leg:**

6: Join in the first unused dc on round6 and work as per the first leg.

Weave in the ends and you're done!
