



All of the above outfits included except the crochet hat in the upper right.

Mini Weebee crochet and knit outfits

these fit a mini Weebee 4.5 inches tall.

Materials:

- sportweight yarn. I used Knit Picks Brava Sport
- Size C (2.5mm) crochet hook
- Size 2 (3.00mm) knitting needles (both straight and dpns)
- ¼ inch buttons

Crochet gauge: not important if you use the same hook and yarn as the doll

Knitting gauge: 6.5 sts = 1 inch

Note: The beginning ch1 and ch2 do NOT count as stitches.

Stitches:

Picot = ch2, sc in the top of the last st made.

FLO = Front Loop Only

BLO = Back Loop Only

Kinc = K in the front and back loops of the stitches

Kdec = K next two sts together

PM = Place Marker

MM = Move Marker

M = Marker

Crochet dress: Leave a long tail at the beginning to make a ch4 buttonhole loop.

1: Ch21, sc in the second ch from the hook and each ch across, ch1, turn. 20 sc

2: (Sc in the first four sc, two sc in the next sc) across, ch1, turn. 24 sc

3: Sc in the first three sc, ch4, skip next 6 sc, sc in the next 6 sc, ch4, skip the next 6 sc, sc in the last three sc, ch2 turn. Armhole openings made

4: (Dc in the first three sts, 2dc in the next st) across, join, ch2, do not turn. 25Dc

5: (Dc in the first four sts, 2dc in the next st) across, join, ch2, do not turn. 30Dc

6: Dc in each st across, join, ch2, do not turn. 30Dc

7: In the FLO, [(sc, 2dc) in the first st, skip the next st] across. Join and fasten off.

With a contrasting color, join in the unused back loop of the last row and work (dc, picot) in each st across, join, fasten off.

Sleeves (optional)

1: Join with a sl st in the first ch of the underarm, ch2, dc in each ch, in the side of the next st, in each sc across the top of the armhole and in the side of the next st, join, ch1, do not turn. 12dc

2: Sc in each st around, join and fasten off.

With contrasting color, work (sl st, ch1) around the neck edge.

Make a ch4 buttonhole loop with the beginning tail and sew a button opposite.

Crochet nightgown: Leave a long tail at the beginning to make a ch4 buttonhole loop

1: Ch25, sc in the second ch from the hook and each ch across, ch1, turn. 24Sc

2: Sc in the first three sc, ch4, skip next 6 sc, sc in the next 6 sc, ch4, skip the next 6 sc, sc in the last three sc, ch2 turn. Armhole openings made

3: (Dc in the next two sts, ch1) across. Join to the first dc, ch2, do not turn.

4: (Dc in the next two dc, ch1) around. Join, ch2, do not turn.

5: (Dc in the first st, 2dc in the next st, ch1) around. Join, ch2, do not turn.

6-7: (Dc in the first three dc, ch1) around. Join, ch2, do not turn. At the end of round 7, ch1.
8: Sl st into the second dc, ch1, sc in the same st [(dc, picot) three times in the next ch1 space, dc in the same space, skip the next dc, sc in the next dc] around. Join and fasten off.
Make a ch4 buttonhole loop with the beginning tail and sew a button opposite.

Knit sundress with garter stitch bodice:

CO 24 on straight needles, leaving a long tail to make two ch4 buttonhole loops.

1: K24
2: K3, BO6, K6, BO6, K3.
3: K3, CO4, K6, CO4, K3.
4: K20
5: K4, Kinc, K10, Kinc, K4. 22Sts
6: K22
7: K5, Kinc, K10, Kinc, K5. 24 sts
8: K24
9: P24
10: Kinc in every st across., working onto three dpns; 16sts/needle.
11-18: K48
19: P48, bind off knitwise.

With the long tail from the beginning, make two ch4 buttonhole loops along the back side of the dress, one at the neckline and one at the waistline. Sew buttons opposite. Done!

Knit cardigan sweater.

Raglan increase as follows: K up to the third st before the M, Kinc in the next st, K1, MM, K1, Kinc. Work this increase at each marker.

CO20, leaving a long tail to make a ch4 buttonhole loop.

1: K3, PM, K4, PM, K6, PM, K4, PM, K3
2: K20
3: K2, P16, K2
4: Raglan increase. 28 sts
5: K2, P24, K2
6: Raglan increase. 36 sts
7: K2, P32, K2
8: Raglan increase. 44 sts
9: K2, P40, K2
10: K6, BO10, K12, BO10, K6.
11: K2, P20, K2. 24 sts
12: K24
13: K2, P20, K2
14-15: K24, bind off knitwise.

With the long tail at the beginning, make a ch4 buttonhole loop. Weave in the ends and you're done!

Knit cap: worked on dpns. If you use straight needles, the first six rows are garter stitch, the

remaining rows are stockinette stitch. At the end, leave a long enough tail to gather the top of the cap and sew up the back seam.

CO 42 sts on three dpns, 14 sts/needle

1-4: Garter stitch for four rows, beginning with a purl row if working on dpns.

5-17: Stockinette stitch

18: Kdec in each stitch around. 22 sts

19: K22

20: Kdec in each stitch around. 11 sts.

21: K11. Leave a very long tail and thread it through the working stitches and pull tight. Done!
