



Helen Kish Riley-size socks

baw 8-21-2011

Simple tube socks for Riley/ Tulah/Zsu Zse/Avery

Materials:

- Size 12 perle cotton (or size 30 crochet cotton)
- Size 9 steel hook

Picot = ch3, sl st in top of the last sc

Note: Chain 18 will yield a bobby socks size sock (slightly over the ankle). For longer socks, chain a few more, ending with an even number of ch. This makes a lacy sock that works well with shoes that need to fit over socks to fit well.

Socks: leave a beginning tail long enough to sew the toe of the sock closed.

1: Chain 18, sc in second ch from the hook; ch2, skip next ch, sc in the next ch, across. Ch2, turn.

2-9: Sc in the first ch2 space, (ch2, sc in the next ch2 space) across, ch2, turn. At the end of row 9, ch1

turn.

10: Sc in the ch2 space on row 1, ch1, sc in the next ch2 space on row 8, ch1; work back and forth across the first and last rows to make a tube of your work. At the end of the row, ch1 and work the next row across the top of the tube. Do not fasten off.

Top trim: In the ch2 spaces at the top of the tube work (three sc, picot) around, Join to the first sc and fasten off.

Sew the toe closed and now you have a tiny sock!
