



Simply Ami Knit Shrug

Fits 8.5 inch Simply Ami crochet doll or other similarly sized dolls.

Materials:

- Fingering weight yarn. Model used Knit Picks Palette in Indigo Heather
- Size 2.0mm double point needles for sleeve ribbing
- Size 2.75 mm double point needles for body of shrug and collar
- Size 3.25 needle to bind off shrug collar
- Size C crochet hook to pick up collar stitches

Gauge: 17 sts = 2 inches in stockinette with 2.75mm needles

Kinc = lifted increase.

Kdec = knit two together.

Notes: the shrug begins with the cuff of one sleeve worked in the round. Once the sleeve length is complete, continue working back and forth (not in the round) for the body of the shrug, then back to knitting in the round for the second sleeve.

CO 20 sts to 2.0mm needle and divide over three needles: 8 sts, 4 sts, 8 sts.

1-5: K2, P2 ribbing around

6: K20, change to 2.75 mm needles at the end of round 6

7-20: K20

21: Needle 1: K8

Needle 2: K1, Kinc, K2, Kinc, K1 (6 sts total)

Needle 3: K8

22: K22

23: Needle 1: K8

Needle 2: K1, Kinc, K4, Kinc, K1 (8 sts total)

Needle 3: K8

24: K24

25: Begin working back and forth, K24

26: P24

27: K24

28-50: repeat rows 26 and 27, ending with a purl row.

51: K24, at the end of this row, return to knitting in the round.

52: K24

53: Needle 1: K8

Needle 2: K1, Kdec, K2, Kdec, K1 (6 sts)

Needle 3: K8

54: K22

55: Needle 1: K8

Needle 2: K1, Kdec, Kdec, K1 (4 sts)

Needle 3: K8

56-69: K20, change to 2.00 mm needles at the end of round 69

70: K20

71-75: K2, P2 ribbing around, at the end of round 75, bind off loosely knitwise.

Ribbed collar: With the right side facing you, divide the opening in the front of the shrug into four equal sections. With a C hook, pick up 14 sts in each section and place them on a 2.75 mm dpn. Four needles, 14 sts on each needle, 56 sts total.

1: K56

2: on each needle, K3, Kinc, K8, Kinc, K3. 16 sts per needle, 64 sts total

3-8: K2, P2 ribbing around. At the end of round 8 with a size 3.25 mm needle, bind off knitwise.

Weave in the loose ends and you are done!
