



Travel doll knit cardigan sweater

Materials:

- It worsted yarn. I used Patons Canadiana
- size 6 single point needles
- size D crochet hook

Gauge: 4 sts = 1 inch in stockinette

This is a truly simple drop shoulder sweater knit in five rectangles: one for the back, two for the front, and two for the sleeves. No shaping required :-)

Back:

CO 16

1-4: K16

5: P16

6: K16

7- 20: Repeat rows 5 and 6

21-23: K16, bind off knitwise at the end of row 23. Leave a long tail to sew or crochet shoulder seam

Right Front:

CO 8

1-4: K8

5: P5, K3

6: K8

7-20: Repeat rows 5 and 6

21-23: K8, bind off knitwise at the end of row 23.

Left Front:

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CO 8

1-4: K8

5: K3, P5

6: K8

7-20: Repeat rows 5 and 6

21-23: K8, bind off knitwise at the end of row 23.

With right sides together sew or slip stitch shoulder seams for four sts.

Sleeves: along one sweater side, measure two inches from the bottom of the sweater on both the front and back and mark for the beginning and end of the sleeves. Right side facing and using the crochet hook, pick up 16 stitches evenly between the marks.

1: P16

2: K16

3- 20: Repeat rows 1 and 2

21-22: K16, bind off knitwise at the end of row 22. Do not cut yarn; with right sides together and using a D crochet hook, sl st the sleeve and side seam. If you don't want to slip the seam, cut the yarn long and backstitch.

Repeat for opposite sleeve and you're done!
