



Rompers for Ginger Kate

fits a 12 inch Waldorf style doll

Materials:

- Worsted yarn, the model uses Berrocco Vintage
- Size 4 (3.5mm) dpn's
- Size E crochet hook

Gauge: 5 sts = 1 inch

Stitches: Kdec = knit two sts tog

Kinc = lifted increase or knit front-to-back

Link st = ch3, dc in the third ch from the hook (one link made), ch3, dc in the third ch from the hook (second link made). Continue for the number of links needed.

These rompers start at the bodice and are worked in the round. The straps and sleeve caps are crocheted, but if you prefer you could knit them instead.

CO 40 and divide evenly over four dpn's, 10 sts per needle.

1: K1 around

2: P1, K1 around

3-10: Repeat rounds 1 and 2 for broken rib bodice.

11: K1 around. Change to second color after this round if desired.

12: K1 around.

13 (K1, Kinc) around. 60 sts total, 15 on each needle.

14-30: K1 around. 60 sts

Divide for the legs

31: Place the sts from needles 3 and 4 on a piece of waste yarn. Work the sts on needles 1 and 2 for the first leg, placing the 30 sts evenly on three needles, 10 sts per needle.

32-38: K1 around, 30 sts

39: (K1, Kdec) around. 20 sts. Change to first color after this round if desired.

40: K1 around.

41: P1, K1 around.

42-45: repeat rounds 40 and 41 for broken rib cuff. Bind off knitwise.

Sew the opening between the legs closed and weave in the loose ends.

For the shoulder straps, with size E hook join with a sc in the first st at the back of the bodice, sc in the next five sts, work four links, skip next eight sts, sc in the next 12 sts, work four links, skip next eight sts, sc in the last six sts. Join with a sl st to the first sc and finish off.

To finish the armhole openings, join yarn with a sc in the fourth st of the underarm. Sc in the next four sts, work four sc in each link across the top of the armhole (16 sc total), sc in the last three sts of the underarm. Join with a sl st to the first sc and finish off. Weave in the ends and you are done!
